



Double Weekend Yields Two Top-Tens

Long Grove, IL (August 30, 2007) – The double-race weekend at Infineon Raceway in Sonoma, CA found Jonathan Klein back in the race car for the first time since his back injuries at Mid-Ohio in July. Cleared by the IRL doctors to race on the road course, Jonathan piloted the #2 Xtreme Coil Drilling racing machine to two top-ten finishes.

The Carneros 100 on Saturday, had Klein starting in the 8th spot on the grid, finishing the 30-lap race in 9th, where he would then start Sunday's race. A revised set-up to the car by Team Moore gave him a better-performing car for Race 2 that he propelled to a 6th-place finish in Sunday's Valley of the Moon 100, with some smooth passing and holding off a last-lap charge by Mike Potekhen in the final turn.

Team Moore now looks forward to the Indy Pro Series season finale at Chicagoland Speedway on September 9. In 2006, Jonathan's second-place finish at the season finale at Chicagoland resulted in the closest margin in the history of the IPS championship, with Jonathan taking second-place in the championship, four points behind the 2006 champion.

The Infineon races are scheduled to be broadcast on ESPN2 on Friday, August 31 at 5:30 – 6:30 pm Eastern time.
