



Top Five for Klein in Nashville

Long Grove, IL (July 16, 2007) – Jonathan Klein drove a smart race in the Music City to score a top five finish in Round 11 of the 2007 Indy Pro Series. Although the car did not qualify for the 100-mile race where the team would have liked, the eleventh starting spot was not indicative of the good racing set-up provided by the Team Moore Racing crew. During the post-qualifying practice session on Friday evening, Jonathan climbed to 4th-place while driving through traffic.

Lap 1 of Saturday's race brought out the first yellow flag, as four cars were involved in an incident that took place after Klein initially moved up four spots in the Xtreme Coil racing machine. The restart had him moving up one more place to sixth, and although Jonathan slipped back to 7th on lap 51 of the 77 lap race, a late race restart had him catapulting up to 5th-place two laps from the finish.

"Considering we started the race in 11th, a top five is a good finish. I want to keep running up in the front. We are improving, and Team Moore Racing and Tom Wood gave me a race car that I could drive all the way to the checkered flag. We came away with some solid points and some good momentum going into Mid-Ohio."

The Indy Pro Racing Sunbelt 100 from Nashville will be run on Wednesday, July 18 at 5:00 pm Eastern time, on ESPN2.
