



Double-Header Weekend at Watkins Glen

Long Grove, IL (July 10, 2007) – The Corning Twin 100s two races at Watkins Glen International this past weekend presented some challenges to Jonathan Klein and his Team Moore Racing crew. They struggled with establishing effective grip along with ultimate speed on the #2 Xtreme Coil racing machine, and Friday's two practice sessions placed the car in 5th and 9th respectively. As a result, overall qualifying culminated in a 9th-place on the grid for Saturday's Race 1.

The start of the race had Klein slipping back to 11th, and he was unable to challenge on two restarts in his usual way. Race 1 had Jonathan finishing 11th, which is where he would then start Sunday's race, as finishing order for the first race determined Race 2's starting lineup.

Race 2 began more like Jonathan's typical race start, as the car set-up had improved over Saturday's. He moved up to the 7th spot, improving four positions by the end of Lap 1. He slipped back to 8th, and then to 9th a few laps from the finish, as the car suffered the effects of a long race.

"Well, this was a frustrating weekend. We finished outside of the top five for both races, but these kinds of things happen. Everyone's going to have an off weekend once in a while but right now, Team Moore Racing and myself are just focusing on Nashville and doing as well as we can there."
