Klein and Camara Wrap Up First 2006 Test at Texas

FT. WORTH, Texas (Jan. 30, 2006) – Jonathan Klein and Jaime Camara, who are competing for Andretti Green Racing in the 2006 Indy Pro Series, wrapped up their first test of the season Monday at Texas Motor Speedway.

Klein, who is a freshman at the University of Dayton, put the #26 machine -- which is sponsored by Klein Tools and Turn-Key Forging and Design, Inc. -- through its paces alongside Camara, who is piloting the #1 CELG-sponsored entry this season after winning two Pro Series races in 2005. Both cars are being prepared by Sam Schmidt Motorsports this season and will be run as Andretti Green Racing entries.

The 2006 Indy Pro Series, which features 12 events, kicks off on March 26 at Homestead-Miami Speedway.

Jonathan Klein:

"I had the best day I've ever had in a race car. I've never been so pleased. I've never had a day go so smooth. It was awesome. The team had a great attitude toward the test and put forth a great effort all day, which gave me a lot of confidence in the car. The car was great. I was flat all the way round after just five or six laps, and that was just my first time in the car. It was a great day."

Jaime Camara:

"For me, yesterday was really more of a shake-down. It had been a while since I'd been in the car, so it just a case of getting back in and getting comfortable. We did about 100 miles in the car on cold tires. Texas is pretty easy to drive by yourself and that's the way it was yesterday. It's fun in traffic, too, but it's pretty easy when you're running by yourself."
