



## Schedule Change for 2005 Star Mazda to Support Formula One in Montreal

(Long Grove, IL, January 21, 2005) - The Star Mazda Championship Presented by Goodyear recently announced that a schedule change has been implemented for the 2005 season. Circuit Gilles Villeneuve in Montreal is now the venue for the June 11<sup>th</sup> Star Mazda race, when Star Mazda serves as a support race for the most popular and recognizable race series in the world, Formula One. Jonathan has been busy in the "off-season" testing with Andersen Walko Racing in preparation for the series' start at Sebring in March, putting in plenty of miles around the tracks at BeaverRun, PA, Carolina Motorsports Park in Kershaw, SC and Sebring, FL with an upcoming test session at Road Atlanta next month. The team has expanded to a four-car effort in Star Mazda for 2005, which will make for plenty of technical and engineering information exchanges within the team.
